Mediterranean Architectural Competition: Results

In July 2002 the Greek Aluminium Rolling Company ELVAL S.A. and the Greek Aluminium Extrusion Company ETEM S.A. launched an international competition for Sustainable Mediterranean Architecture with Aluminium Façades. Held under the auspices of the International Union of Architects (UIA), the competition was open to concepts or ideas by Students from Schools of Architecture, Technical Universities and Polytechnics as well as by Professional Architects from countries around the Mediterranean Basin.

OBJECTIVES

- * Raise awareness of environmental issues among students and architects;
- * Disseminate the facts on Aluminium and its contribution to sustainability;
- * Promote new ideas for low-energy buildings using Aluminium façades;
- * Stimulate the exchange of best-practice on the use of Aluminium as a building material around the Mediterranean.

JURY

The international jury consisted of chairman Alexandros Tombazis, Architect (Greece) and members Achraf Bahri-Meddeb, Architect (Tunisia), Thomas Herzog, Architect (Germany), Constantin Catsaros, President of Greek Aluminium Association, Maximos Chrisomallidis, Architect (Greece), Federico Mazzolani, Civil Engineer (Italy), Necdet Teymur, Architect (Turkey) plus deputy members Ilias Zacharopoulos, Architect (Greece) and Nebojsa Minjevic, Architect (Serbia & Montenegro).

ENTRIES

The jury convened in Athens between 10 and 12 October 2003 and considered 48 entries out of a total of 286 valid registrations in both student and professional categories. After adjudication was completed in strict anonymity, the envelopes were opened and the names of the winners were revealed (see below).
