ELVAL was awarded the third-place prize for its innovative 2011 Corporate Responsibility and Sustainable Development Report, by the University of the Aegean, in the CSR Reporting Forum 2012, organized by the company Sustainable Development.

Participants in the CSR Reporting Forum, which took place on December 18, 2012, had the opportunity, among other issues, to be informed on the quality of CSR Reports published and the range of actions and best practices implemented with consistency and continuity, as regards Corporate Social Responsibility, in Greece.

In the last session of the event, the report-evaluation conducted annually by the team of Assistant Professor Constantine Evaggelinos was presented. The evaluation was based, this year, on the specifications of the revised Guidelines GRI-G3.1, both as regards conformity to the relevant indicators as well as meeting and implementing the relevant CSR principles. The event concluded by the award of prizes and distinctions to the Greek companies which attained the highest scores.

ELVAL attained the third place and was awarded the third prize. ELVAL was awarded by the University of the Aegean, for the third consecutive year, confirming the company's commitment to operate responsibly, creating sustainable value for its stakeholders.
